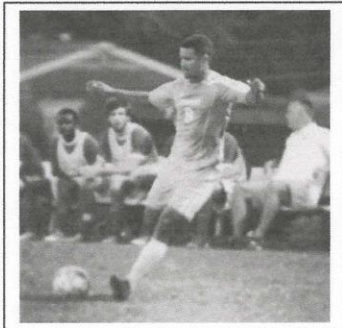
Meeting Minutes

1. Approving new club president

 - Unanimously voted Austin O'Brien as new President

2. Uniforms
 - Working with Meredith Davis with Soccer.com on next season uniforms
 - All agreed there isn't anything wrong with the uniforms we currently have, all players like the shorts and have no complaints about the shirts, socks, etc

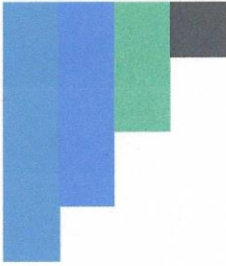
